Re: **May 2020 - Borough Manager's Report**

Administration / Finance

- Insurance Claims & Matters:
 - Workers Compensation Claims:
 - Chief's COVID-19 claim submitted to carrier; details contained within COVID-19 log.
- Grant Projects (*Awards Since Last Meeting / New Activity – Grant Log Attached*)
 - DCNR - Henning Street Playground Project – submitted grant application seeking \$315,527 for the project.
 - DCED – Henning Street Playground Project – application prepared, waiting on Council's authorization to submit. Seeking \$250,000 for the project.
- Right to Know Requests – 2 requests this month: diesel vendor invoices and March Tax Collectors Report.
- Drafted May Coffee Talk article for Chamber of Commerce newsletter, attached.
- Audits:
 - 2019 Borough Audit –underway. Planning on yearly presentation of Audit for June meeting.
 - 2017-19 Ambridge VFD Relief Association – State Audit completed, no findings or observations. Report within Council packets.
- 2020 Budget / Finances – General Fund: Revenue at 45%, Expenditures at 30.60%. Anticipate shortfalls in Act 511 taxes, permits and fines as result of COVID-19 shutdowns. Anticipate effects to be felt come the third quarter. I recommend a spending freeze be put into place to help mitigate.
- 2019 Delinquent Real Estate Taxes turned over to the Tax Claim Bureau. Amount turned over was \$264,880.84, last year amount turned over \$249,365.77. Difference credited to one property owner who owns a substantial amount of real estate within the Borough who is delinquent in taxes.
- TAN loan from Sinking Fund to General Fund was paid back to the Sinking Fund on April 30, 2020 in the amount of \$245,000.

Code Enforcement / Planning

- Multiple zoning-related permits issued – separate report included within the monthly code report highlighting the activity.
- Commercial Demolitions- bids received for demolition of 420 Merchant St on 4/29/20, per the County lowest bid received within budget. County is working on contract documents so that notice to proceed can be issued soon.
- Residential Demolitions – work underway, started May 4th at 1633 Church St, 915 5th Street and 320 Duss.

- Heart and Soul Community Planning – process now starting, but slowly due to COVID-19. Project budget prepared and sent to DCED and Orton Foundation. Supplemental grant application submitted to DCED to match Orton Foundation grant.
- Curb Cut Applications – Wilson Avenue application meets requirements and will go before Council for final determination. Property posted, no comments received.

Fire Department / Public Safety

- Engine 1 Refurbishment: completed, truck back and in service.
- Coronavirus Response – detailed weekly report and log sent to Borough Council and Mayor at the close of each week.
- Fire Department Staff Performance Reviews – currently underway. Fire Chief and I are sitting down with each Firefighter. Going very well so far.
- PENNDOT / Jake-Brake Restriction Request – received a call from PENNDOT on May 7th, a citizen made a request that Route 65 in the Historic District have Jake-brake restrictions in place. If there is interest from Council, we'll need to send a letter to PENNDOT. They would complete a study, no charge. After the study, if warranted, we would then have to prepare / adopt an ordinance and be responsible for the signage.

Public Works

- 2020 Road Program
 - 11th Street from Beaver Road to the Borough Line: Quote received will be on next meeting agenda for consideration. Consider moving forward to take advantage of partnership with Gas Company paving their project areas.
 - 1100 Block of Maplewood – brick restorations: SUGGEST WE HOLD OFF ON THE PROJECT UNTIL FINANCES IMPROVE.
 - DPW Yard / 10th Street between Glenwood and Busway – no update.
- 2020 Shade Tree Maintenance: received quote from contractor, will be on next meeting agenda for consideration.
- 2020 New Shade Trees – replacing trees on 13th, 14th and 4th Street and within PJ Caul Park, nine trees in total using Duquesne Light funding assistance. Sites approved by Shade Tree Commission, marked out, PA One Calls placed, adjacent homeowners notified and DPW will plant in the next month.
- 2021 Refuse Contract – prepared draft contract and bid documents, will need to review with Council and Solicitor before moving forward with advertisement. Current contract expires 12/31/2020.

Parks

- Port-a-johns delivered for the year. Water service to be turned back on this month.

Good morning, Joe. How are you?

We have everything ready to roll on 439-441. As soon as we get the OK from the state that we can move forward with demolitions, I will get the contractor in to sign the contract and schedule a start date. Unfortunately, this contractor did not bid on the 418-420 project.

Our bids yesterday were wide ranging. I've never worked with the lowest bidder, Reilly Contracting out of Valencia. Of course, I will have to do a quick vetting of their credentials. But their bid was roughly \$75,000.00, which if they are confirmed as a responsible bidder, would put us slightly below budget. The next lowest bidder was \$7,000.00 higher so that would put us slightly over budget, but not by much. I am working from home today, so I don't have access to the actual numbers. We did not receive any comments from the public comment period. I did not hear from HUD that they received any comments. So, once this administrative verification is done, we can take the steps to proceed with the resolution and approval by the Commissioners.

When I get to the office tomorrow, I will try to remember to send you the sign that would need to be affixed to both buildings. I'll keep you in the loop as things proceed.





MONTHLY REPORT – MAY 2020

- Street sweeping started on Monday April 6th and runs every other week through October 9th. Currently due to the COVID-19 outbreak enforcement has been suspended, but we still ask citizens to move their cars to keep the community clean.
- Cleaned catch basins and swales throughout town on rainy days. They also emptied and logged collected debris in the catch basin nets in the French Point watershed area.
- Dog park in Walter Panek Park has been reseeded for the season, it is currently closed so that the grass can grow in.
- Yard waste collections have been busy with citizens cleaning up their yards for the spring.
- Grass cutting of parks, borough properties, right of ways, etc. is now underway for the season.
- Electrician is currently working on retrofitting the streetlights on New Economy Drive to LED.
- Equipment Maintenance:
 - Bucket Truck had some electrical repairs made to it and the battery was replaced.
 - Truck 5 – inspected and oil changed
 - Truck 1 (Sweeper) – inspected, didn't need anything.
 - Snow equipment removed from the trucks for the year.
- Sign maintenance is on-going, replacing missing signs and repairing damaged locations.
- Ongoing maintenance has been dedicated to filling potholes and repairs to multiple alleys.
- Foreman responded, marked and reported multiple PA-One Call requests.

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
