MONTHLY REPORT – JUNE 2020

- Street sweeping is ongoing every other week. Parking enforcement is scheduled to begin the week of June 15th. The Police Department will be giving out warning notices in advance. News of the enforcement has been posted on the Borough website, Facebook page, WMBA Radio, Beaver County Times and a text message will be sent out the Friday before.
- Cleaned catch basins and swales throughout town on rainy days. Crew also emptied and logged collected debris in the catch basin nets in the French Point watershed area.
- Yard waste collections have been busy with citizens cleaning up their yards.
- Grass cutting of parks, borough properties, right of ways and abandoned properties is now underway for the season.
- All playground equipment has been mulched for the year.
- Crew planted new street trees on 13th and 14th Streets, replaced a dead one on 4th Street and added two new shade trees to PJ Caul Park.
- Troop banners have been hung for the year throughout town and the Borough Office is still accepting applications for new banners.
- Electrician is currently working on retrofitting the streetlights on Church Street to LED. He also made repairs to the streetlights on Merchant Street in the Historic District.
- Equipment Maintenance:
 - Truck 1– inspected, it needed rear brakes.
- Sign maintenance is on-going, replacing missing signs and repairing damaged locations.
- Ongoing maintenance has been dedicated to filling potholes and repairs to multiple alleys.
- Foreman responded, marked and reported multiple PA-One Call requests.

Engineer's Report

1. Merchant Street (and Municipal Lots) Resurfacing:

- Concrete abutting brick crosswalk in 400 block still needs repaired from edge chipping. Borough is still retaining 5% of final costs until repair is done.
- Spoke to Curt Youngblood who visited the site again and informed me that he expects to get it repaired in the next week or two.

2. 2020 Misc. Road Work:

- Informed Youngblood that Borough had accepted their quote for milling and resurfacing on 11th Street (from Beaver to Borough boundary at Larch) for work outside those areas that Columbia Gas is responsible for due to utility installation. This Borough funded work will result in 11th being completely resurfaced (from curb to curb) in the area.

3. 2020 Road Program:

- Prepared Plans and Specs for 2020 Road Program
- Bids for paving in the Public Works yard and milling and resurfacing of 10th Street (from Park 'n Ride to Glenwood) were due and scheduled to be opened on Thursday, June 4.
- It is my intent to have bids evaluated and have a recommendation to award to lowest responsible bidder at this meeting of Council (June 9).
