MONTHLY REPORT – OCTOBER 2019

- Street-sweeping is underway every other week and increased in French Point Creek Watershed area. Street-sweeping ended for the year on October 4th.
- Curbside leaf collection starts on Monday, October 21st. Please pile your leaves in neat piles at the curb-line, do not park on top of your leaves.
- Streetscape Project: in preparation of the dedication on 9/28, crew finished installation of sponsorship plaques, parking meters, parking lot bumpers, American Flags and completed finishing touches on the project.
- Grass Cutting is underway at Borough Properties, Parks, Rights of Way and Abandoned properties.
- Line Painting: crew has been working the overnight hours repainting all crosswalks, stop bars, parking lines on Merchant Street and Parking Lots, arrows and directions stencils throughout town.
- Park Maintenance: Lion's Club Drinking Fountain Project, crew working with AWA installed new water line into 8th Street Park for the fountain; contractor installed the concrete pad, graded the area around the fountain and installed it on October 1st. Lion's Club is planning on a dedication ceremony on October 10th.
- Electrician repaired the street lighting conduit on Merchant Street in the Historic District struck by AWA Crews working on a water project in the area. He also made repairs to the 11th and Merchant St. signal and changed bulbs on the war monument and in the Borough Building Parking Lot. The Electrician was also a huge help during the festivals on September 28th running additional power connections for the vendors.
- Crew continues to hang Military Troop Banners. Banners are now being hung on Duss Avenue at the north gateway to town.
- Festival Preparation – crews dedicated time to assist with the preparations of Merchant Street for the parade and got both parks ready for the festivals on September 28th. Clean up was a completed, no real issue or problems.
- Equipment Maintenance:
 - Chevy Colorado Pickup – power steering repairs were completed at Loftus's.
- Sign maintenance is on-going, replacing missing signs and repairing damaged locations.
- Ongoing maintenance has been dedicated to filling pot-holes and repairs to multiple alleys.
- Foreman responded, marked and reported multiple PA-One Call requests.

1. Attended monthly meeting of September 10, 2019

2. Merchant Street (and Municipal Lots) Resurfacing:

- Work is complete, and first Payment Application has been reviewed and submitted to the Borough.
- Final inspection was performed on September 16, with NIRA, Hancock, Youngblood, and Borough in attendance.
- Punchlist was issued to Youngblood, and 5% of construction costs were retained until punchlist items are completed.

3. Annual MS4 Report:

- Completed and submitted annual report to DEP.

Miscellaneous:

- Investigated storm manhole on Church Street at Central Lane due to slight depressions in pavement on either side of manhole. Heavy infiltration indicated possible water main break, which was confirmed by AWA. Break was repaired, and subsequent inspection of manhole and pipes showed that the storm sewer was structurally sound.
