MONTHLY REPORT – DECEMBER 2019

- Curbside leaf-vac collection ended on Friday, December 6th. Yard waste collection will continue; however, debris will need to be bagged for it to be picked up. Paper yard waste bags are encouraged as they also can be composted.
- Gas line to the DPW Building was replaced by City Plumbing on November 12th after receiving repair order from Columbia Gas.
- Crew decorated Merchant Street in the Downtown, Midtown and Historic Districts, PJ Caul Park and the Borough Building for the upcoming holidays.
- Crew cleaned Merchant Street sidewalks, streets, PJ Caul Park and assisted with the Christmas on Merchant parade and event on December 6th.
- Provided letters to all downtown Merchant Street property owners asking them to not use rock salt but calcium chloride products on the new concrete sidewalks.
- Troop Banners have been taken down for the year and will be rehung next Memorial Day.
- Equipment Maintenance:
 - Two Salt Hoppers Repaired and Serviced at US Municipal
 - Bucket Truck Inspected – did not need anything.
 - Streetsweeper winterized and placed in the fire station for seasonal storage.
- Sign maintenance is on-going, replacing missing signs and repairing damaged locations.
- Ongoing maintenance has been dedicated to filling pot-holes and repairs to multiple alleys.
- Foreman responded, marked and reported multiple PA-One Call requests.
