RECYCLING GUIDELINES

Plastic Bottles & Jugs



Paperboard or Boxboard



Cardboard Boxes





Glass Jars & Bottles





Place <u>all</u> of your recyclable materials in the new green bin. No need to separate it. Leave it loose or in a brown paper bag. Do not place any of it in a plastic bag. Place bin at curb or in an accessible area for pick up.

Yes!

- ✓ Glass bottles and jars. Rinsed and empty of contents. Remove lids. Do not break.
- ✓ Tin, metal beverage and food containers, metal lids. Rinsed and empty of contents.
- ✓ Aluminum cans. Empty of contents.
- ✓ Paper from news, magazines, junk mail, construction paper, catalogs, paper bags.
- ✓ Boxboard or paperboard like cereal boxes, cracker boxes, shoe boxes, pizza boxes, soda and beer cartons, paper towel tubes. Clean and empty of contents. No liners.
- ✓ Aluminum foil/pie pans Rinsed and empty of contents.
- ✓ Plastic—# 1 and # 2 (PET & HDPE) like pop bottles, milk jugs and laundry detergent containers. Rinsed and empty of contents. Remove lids.
- ✓ Cardboard Boxes—broken down so that it is flat.

No!

- Garbage Bags or Plastic Grocery Bags
- Garbage
- × Food Waste
- Diapers
- Wax or plastic wrap or bags
- Plastic deli bags or take out packaging
- Styrofoam or Styrofoam packing peanuts
- Window glass, ceramics or dishware, mirror or light bulbs / fluorescent light bulbs.
- Dog waste or kitty litter
- Tupperware or Rubbermaid plastic containers

These items go in the trash can.
