1. Consider Action to Approve waiving the back taxes on Tax Parcel 10-004-0616-000 a vacant lot located at 5th St & Wilson. Municipal Taxes owed are \$405.95 for 2016-2022 at the request of Tom Fedorko.
2. Consider Action to award 90' x 5' concrete sidewalk replacement work along Duss Avenue to Avelli Construction Corp in the amount of \$9,000.00
3. Consider Action to approve adding rules and regulations for the Walter Panek Park to include “NO” Metal Detecting and “NO” Quad or off-road vehicles permitting on Park property
